



HR Power Breakfast Meetings Establishing Global Talent Mobility Programs

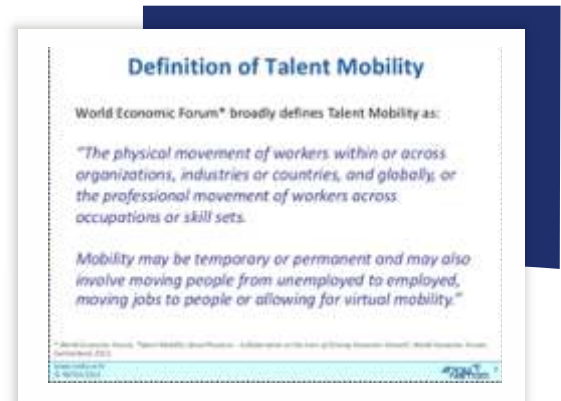
